- (1) Address the degree to which the high priority actions items in the sustainability plan have been met by the Brattleboro Retreat.
- (2) Summarize any concerns identified that would impact the ability of the Retreat to achieve the financial sustainability goal of the plan by the September 30, 2020.
- (3) Identify additional policy and fiscal decisions that may need to be taken, and the timeframe for such decisions to be made in the event identified concerns cannot be addressed and/or the sustainability goal is unlikely to be met.
