  - 1. <u>Total Amount Requested: \$250,000.</u> The Agency of Commerce and Community Development (ACCD) is seeking funding to contract with Maximus for a call center to provide technical assistance to Vermont employers applying for Economic Relief Grants.

2. <u>Total Amount Requested: \$1,789,249.25.</u> The Agency of Digital Services (ADS) is seeking reimbursement for Coronavirus Relief Fund (CRF) grant implementation project costs. ADS employed a technical tool, Salesforce, to provide the technology needed for the State to manage several CRF grant programs. Unbudgeted implantation costs include implementation vendor costs, ADS implantation staff and software licensing costs.

3. Total Amount Requested: \$1,850,000. Agency of Natural Resources

- a. *Total Amount Requested: \$450,000*. The Department of Forests, Parks and Recreation (FPR) is seeking funding to purchase three large format scanners to digitize use value appraisal records. Vermont's Use Value Appraisal (UVA) Program enables eligible private landowners who practice long-term forestry to have their land appraised based on the property's value for production of wood rather than its residential or commercial development value under normal ad valorem taxation...
- b. *Total Amount Requested:* \$1,400,000. The Agency of Natural Resources (ANR) is requesting funding to support retooling ANR's approach to regulatory review and environmental permitting to allow for and support increased telework, doing so in a manner that enhances technical assistance available to applicants, improves the timeliness of regulatory review and ensures public participation processes are maintained or enhanced.
- 4. Total Amount Requested: \$410,000. The Department of Financial Regulation (DFR) is seeking funding to contract with the consulting firm Oliver Wyman for modeling and consulting work related to Vermont's COVID-19 response. The requested amount (\$410,000) will fund the modeling contract through December 2020.

5. <u>Total Amount Requested: \$500,000.</u> The Department of Mental Health (DMH) is seeking funding for suicide prevention efforts that will support Vermonters whose mental health has been significantly impacted by the COVID-19 pandemic. <u>Sec. 9 of Act136 of 2020</u>

6. Total Amount Requested: \$80,113. The Natural Resources Board (NRB) is tasked with administering Act 250, Vermont's land use and planning law. The NRB is seeking funding to expedite Covid-19 permitting by digitizing a subset of our permit files, those that are most directly related to Vermont's emergency response to Covid-19. The NRB would require additional staff to complete the

digitization process. The NRB requests funding to hire a qualified Temporary Service Position to perform the functions required to digitize the required records.

7. Total Amount Requested: \$18,750,000.

- a. *UI Modernization* (\$750,000): VDOL is requesting funding to contract with a vendor to begin modernizing the Unemployment Insurance (UI) through the implantation of a mainframe software system (Mulesoft) and the digitization of records.
- b. *UI Operations* (\$18,000,000): VDOL is requesting funding for reimbursement of expenses incurred from contracting with Maximus to operate the UI call center and for additional funds to extend Maximus' contract through December 2020.
