Esteemed Chairs.

In accordance with Sec. 7(d) of Act 137, the Department of Taxes, on behalf of the Secretary of Administration, is providing a report on the Local Government Expense Reimbursement Grants (LGER).

Applications for the LGER grants were accepted through September 4th, 2020. Applications were structured to limit up front effort on behalf of the towns and captured expenses incurred up to the time of application as well as projected expenses through December 30, 2020. Multiple outreach efforts were conducted through municipal listservs, press releases, and educational webinars with partners such as regional planning commissions to make towns aware of the application and due date.

As of September 15, 2020, 132 applications have been submitted for LGER grants with a total amount of \$7.6M in requests. An additional \$1.5M of claims were submitted to the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) and some of those claims will likely be denied, triggering potential eligibility for additional LGER claims. Currently, the amount of FEMA claims which may be denied is unknown, thus, the Department estimates the total amount of potential expenditure for LGER at this time at \$9.1M.

A complete list of applicants can be found in Attachment 1 of this document with a breakdown of expense categories in Attachment 2. Applications are currently being reviewed by Department of Taxes staff and awards are being issued. Additional instructions have been created for grantees to advise them how to submit documentation of expenses to receive their grant awards. Because of the compressed application period which was initially offered to assess outstanding need for municipal grants, it is possible that a small number of municipalities who intended to apply were not able to do so. It is also possible that the applications which have been submitted consider only reactive expenses to COVID-19 and do not incorporate proactive or structural improvements to enable communities to navigate restrictions and continue to serve the public.

Recommendation: It is the recommendation of the Secretary of Administration that no legislative action is necessary at this time and that the existing LGER appropriation be maintained with the intention of reopening applications and extending the application deadline to October 1st. New and amended applications would be accepted and an additional outreach effort would be conducted in coordination with the Agency of Commerce and Community Development to educate towns on the proactive uses such as modification of public spaces like libraries or coordination with local businesses to support fall season outdoor seating to which the LGER grants could be applied.
