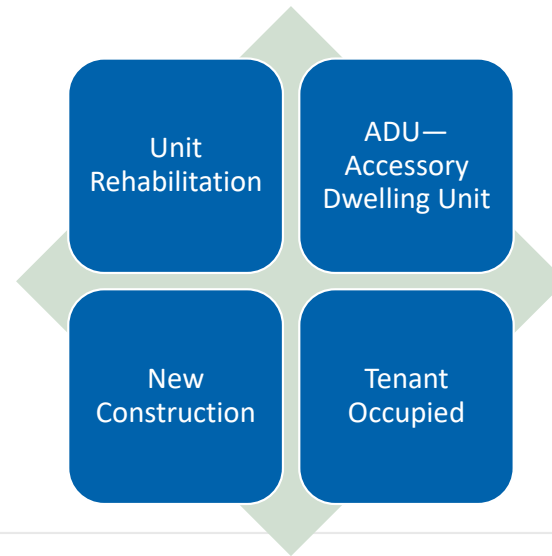




What is VHIP 2.0?

- VHIP 2.0 is a program to help repair Vermont's housing stock and provide long-term affordable housing to our vulnerable residents.
- You can repair existing units, build new ones, or add an ADU to your personal property.

445 affordable rental units brought back to life in all 14 counties!

356 more units are underway.

300+ VHIP 2.0 units are in review.

A great use of tax dollars. The average grant is **\$44,000!**

80% of units provided stable, permanent housing for Vermonters exiting homelessness.



Accessory Dwelling Units (ADUs)

24 Units Completed.

58 Units Underway.

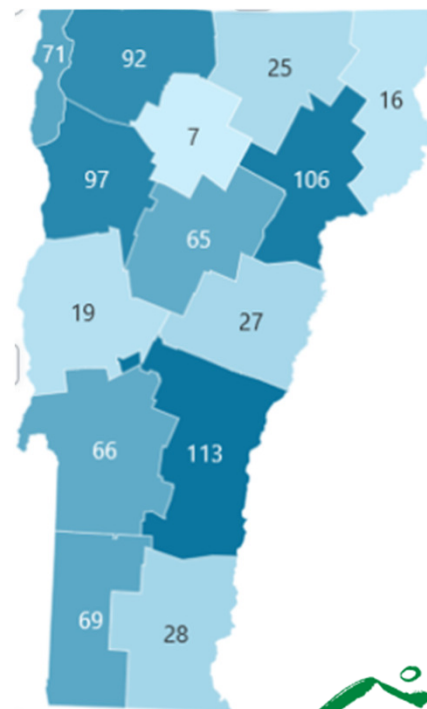
\$3.9 Million invested through
VHIP!

\$48.6 Million of investment in affordable housing!

- \$13.4 Million invested in completed units.
- \$15.2 Million obligated for projects underway.
- \$20 Million ear marked for applications under review.

Average match is \$13,500 per project.
