



## Manufactured Home Improvement and Repair Program

### September 2024 Program Update

The Manufactured Home Improvement and Repair (MHIR) program supports park improvements, home repairs, and foundation installation in manufactured home communities in Vermont. The program launched in February of 2023 and has been supported by ARPA Revenue Replacement Funding and State General Funds.



### Program Totals

- ▶ **590** Total Projects Approved
- ▶ **\$6.7M** Out of \$7M Obligated for Awards
- ▶ **105** Mobile Home Parks Have Participated
- ▶ **880** Applications Submitted



### Home Repair Awards

- ▶ Park improvements to infill vacant or abandoned lots within park. Maximum award per lot is \$20K.
- ▶ **313** Homes
- ▶ **\$13K** Average Cost per home



### Infill Awards

- ▶ Home repairs or accessibility projects that ensure occupants will remain healthily housed. Maximum award per home is \$18K.
- ▶ **123** Lots
- ▶ **\$14K** Average per Lot



### Foundation Awards

- ▶ Foundation, Skirting, and Utility Connections for Purchasing of a Mobile Home for a Vacant Lot. Maximum Award of \$15K.
- ▶ **57** Foundations
- ▶ **\$13.6K** Average per Foundation Project
