Enclosed please find one (1) item, which the Joint Fiscal Office has received from the Administration.

JFO #3206: Land donation to the Agency of Natural Resources, Department of Fish and Wildlife from the Virginia Brooks Estate. The parcel of land is undevelopable and abuts two existing department parcels. Acceptance will allow an expanded area of protection of the diverse wetland habitats along the Barton River in Glover, Vermont. The parcel is valued at \$10,300.00. Closing costs of \$4,000.00 are funded by budgeted federal funds. Estimated annual payment in lieu of taxes (PILOT) is \$58.99 annually. [Received July 1, 2024]

Dear Mr. Emerson.

The Town of Glover Selectboard is pleased to submit this letter in support of the proposed property donation by the Brooks' family to the Vermont Fish & Wildlife Department. We understand the donation will place the property, SPAN 243-077-10087, under permanent conservation protection for use and enjoyment by the residents of Glover and the public in perpetuity. The Selectboard recognizes that the property is abutted by the State-owned Clark Pond Fishing Access (SPAN 243-077-10223) to the south and a Barton River Streambank Management Area to the north (Lot: 401-705). Furthermore, we understand the property is vacant, devoid of any structures or improvements, and has approximately 275-feet of water frontage and 325-feet of road frontage. As such, the Selectboard recognizes and supports the goal of permanently conserving the property to provide quality fish habitat, protect water quality, promote flood resilient land uses, and enhance public access for recreational activities in the region.

We recognize the property belonged to Vivian H. Brooks for many years and that after her passing, the parcel went to probate as part of her estate proceedings. As the executor of the estate, Mr. William Brooks obtained a license to sell or convey the property which was approved by a Vermont judge on February 2, 2023. As part of this process, Mr. brooks also obtained an approved Notice of Commencement of Estate, an approved Motion to Waive Notice to Creditors, and an approved Certificate of Appointment of Fiduciary.

Sustaining excellent water quality and a robust recreational fishery in the Barton River is important for Glover as visitors and residents flock to the area because of our abundant and pristine waterbodies. The conservation of this undeveloped parcel will help maintain clear, cold water in the watershed by reducing sediment and nutrients entering the Barton River and ultimately Lake Memphremagog. As outlined in the Memphremagog Tactical Basin Plan, reducing nutrient loading into the watershed can be attained by permanently protecting lakeshores and rivers. We are pleased to hear the Vermont Fish and Wildlife plan to steward the property in a manner that optimizes natural ecosystem services while providing public access.

Additionally, the Board is pleased to know that the multi-generational family landowner, Mr. William Brooks, is an enthusiastic proponent of this project. We recognize and appreciate his eagerness to protect the valuable natural resources associated with this land and open it up for the enjoyment by the public.

Dear Jaye,

Enclosed is an approval memo for Governor Scott's consideration authorizing the Department of Fish and Wildlife (DFW) to receive a donation of 0.72 (+/-) acres in the town of Glover to expand the existing Barton River Streambank Management Area (SMA).

The DFW is accepting this property as a donation, with funds for closing from the Great Lakes Fisheries Commission (GLFC) and the Vermont Housing and Conservation Board (VHCB). The Town of Glover supports this donation; a copy of an approval letter from their select board is attached. Funding for the continued management and stewardship will come from the DFW's existing USFWS Sportfish Restoration Grant, Aquatic Habitat Project. As with previous ANR land acquisitions via donation, the included AA-1 Grants Acceptance form follows the memo to Governor Scott and will serve as the signature page for the required administrative approvals. 

SUBJECT: Fee acquisition of 0.72 acres in Glover, VT to add to Barton River

Streambank Management Area.

<u>Recommendation:</u> Approve the Department of Fish and Wildlife's (VDFW) acquisition of the 0.72 acre Brooks parcel in Glover to add to the existing Barton River Streambank Management Area (SMA).

Description

VDFW is seeking approval to conserve 0.72 acres of wetlands in Glover to expand the existing Barton River Streambank Management Area (SMA). The acquisition will provide access to public lands for hunting, trapping, angling, and wildlife viewing.


The purchase of this site is an ideal opportunity for wetland and floodplain forest restoration for the conservation of wild salmonids and will have the added benefit of providing access to VDFW land for hunting, trapping and angling. For **0.72 acres** of wetlands the total purchase price is **0** and the PILOT payments estimate is **\$58.99** annually.

There are no VAST trails on the property currently. Due to the sensitivity of the wetland habitat, VDFW is not planning to create new trails on this parcel at this time.

The closing costs for this project will be paid with funding from the Great Lakes Fisheries Commission through the Vermont Housing and Conservation Board and are expected to be less than \$4,000. In consideration for the funding, VDFW will grant a right of first refusal to VHCB to maintain public access if the parcel is ever sold. No state general fund monies will be used for this acquisition or the related work. Like all SMAs, the long-term management of the parcel will be paid for with USFWS federal funds. The town Selectboard supports this acquisition by the Department; a signed letter of support is attached.

Approval is requested pursuant to 32 V.S.A. § 5(b)(2), for the approved acceptance of a "grant, gift, loan, or any sum of money or thing of value" to a state Agency. And 10 V.S.A. \$4147 to convey the right of first refusal.
