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# Accountable Care and ACOs



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## “Accountable Care”

- Payment reform based on physicians and hospitals being **accountable for total cost and quality** of health care for an attributed patient population

## “Accountable Care Organization” = ACO

- An voluntary organization of providers participating in population-based programs for Medicare, and/or Medicaid, and/or Commercial Health Plans

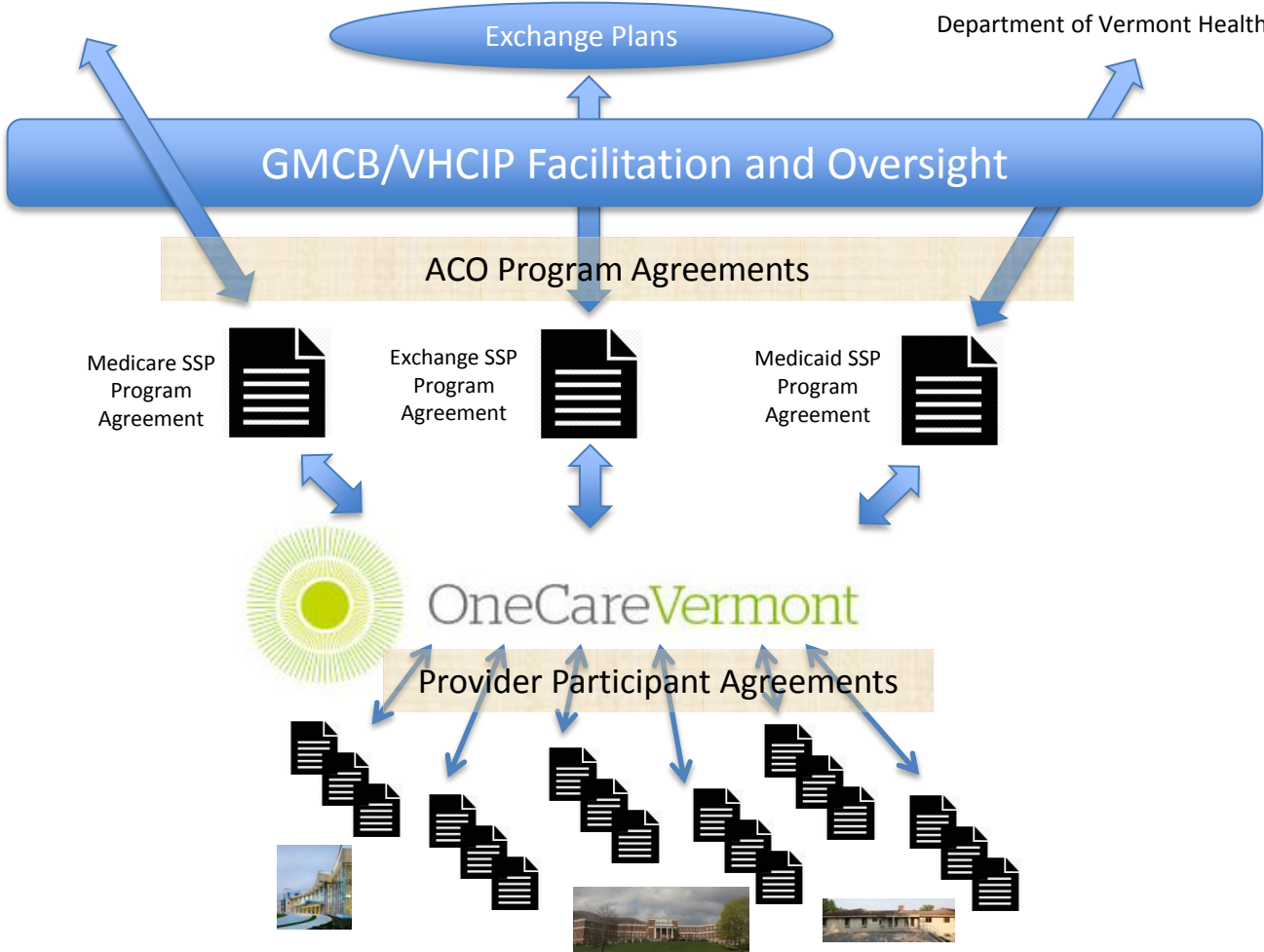
## “Attributed Patient Population”

- Under current ACO programs, determined as those having established primary care relationships with physicians participating in the ACO network

# OneCare 2016/2017 Planning



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- **Primarily driven by Medicare approach**
  - End of current MSSP contract on 1/1/16
    - > Other programs have final year through 2016
  - Medicare is OCV's largest program (providers, attribution, dollars)
  - Medicare participation as central discussion in APM
- **Have pursued 3 concurrent paths**
  - MSSP Renewal
    - > Applied in July (required provider renewal contracts)
    - > Awaiting approval
  - Next Generation ACO Program
    - > Applied in June
    - > Selections in August
    - > Decision due September 14th
  - All-Payer Model
    - > Awaiting information
    - > Expecting 2017 start (if available) with no 2016 transition model
    - > Will assess in context of previous options once more is known
- **Significant engagement in payment reform design and unified ACO discussions for 2017**
